Nota:

Ten en cuenta que los verbos anteriormente expuestos son de todo tipo; regulares, irregulares, reflexivos, etc. Por lo tanto, la conjugación puede variar dependiendo al pronombre usado.

Por tal razón, los verbos señalados en negrilla, como, por ejemplo:

(Acostarse) y luego (me acuesto) son verbos reflexivos, cuya conjugación habitual es usar un pronombre reflexivo.

Note:

Please note that the verbs mentioned above are from all types; regular, irregular, reflexive, etc. Therefore, the conjugation may vary depending on the pronoun used.

For this reason, the verbs marked in bold, for example: **(Acostarse)** and it turns to **(me acuesto)** when it is conjugated. The reason is that they are **reflexive verbs**, whose form of conjugation is to use a **reflexive pronoun**. If you need more information about reflexive pronouns. Check that lesson.



Conclusion

To speak Spanish, it is not necessary to learn **all 93.000** words that exist (data from the Royal Spanish Academy of Language), in fact, in our everyday language we usually use a limited number of these, including the verbs mentioned above. We do not have to be great experts and know this technical language to communicate with others, in fact, knowing half of these verbs will give us incredible results.
